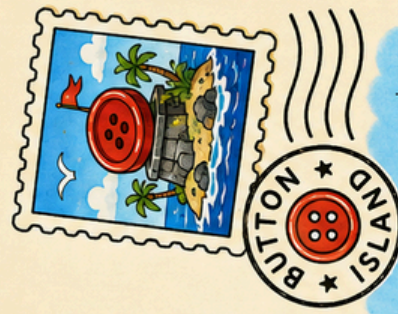

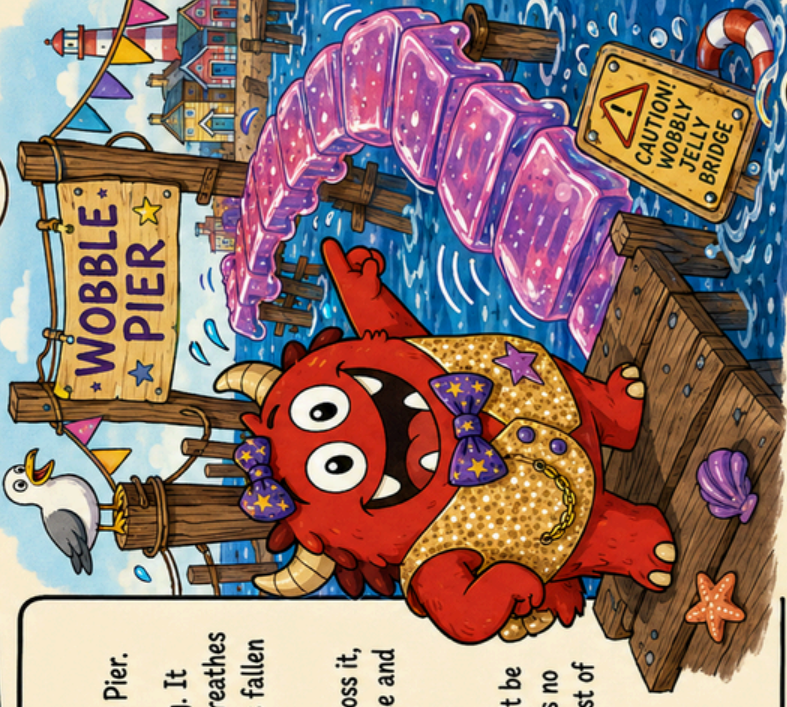


Don't Be Boring Boris
